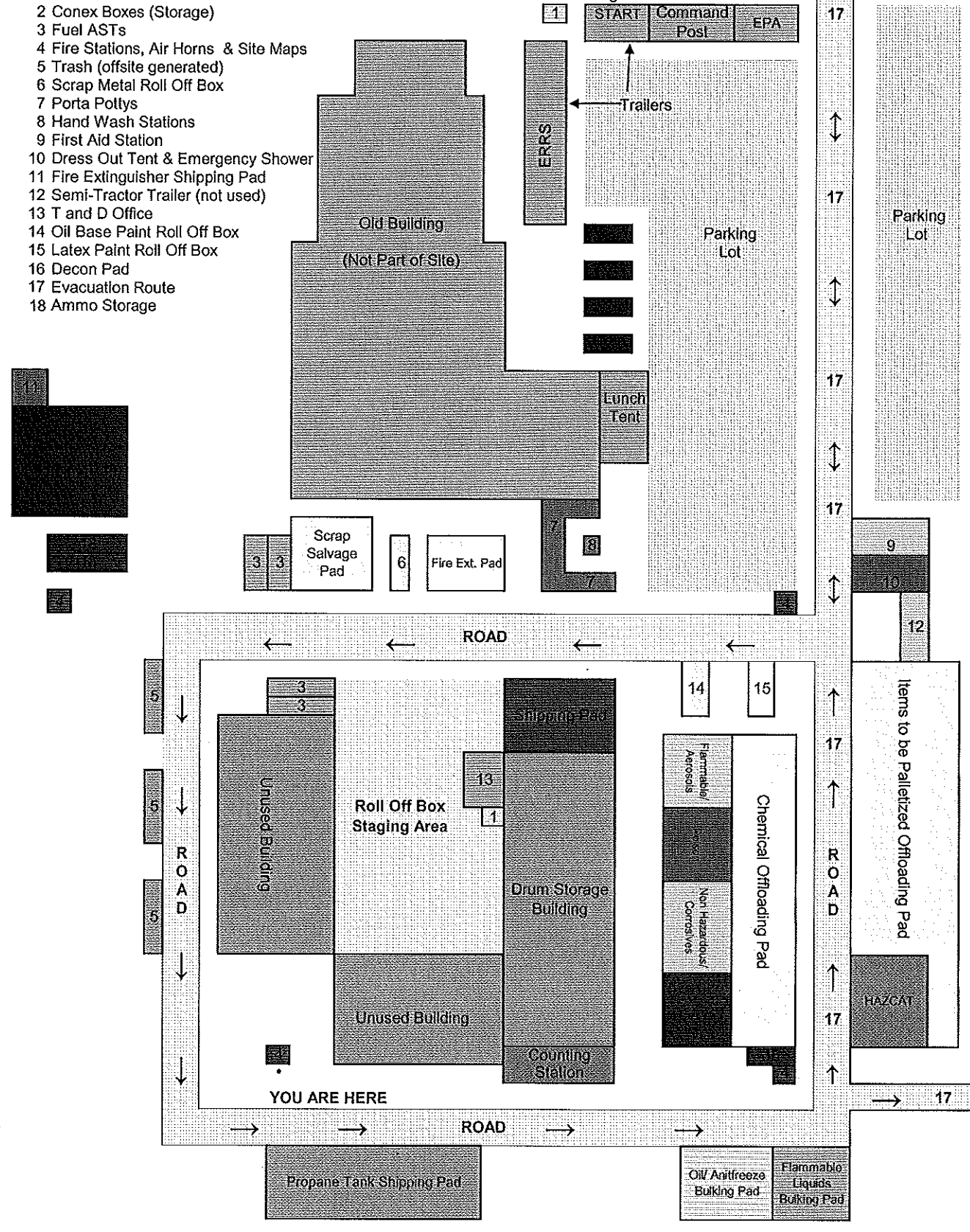

Note: The size of the Waste Collection Pad will depend primarily on 2 factors: 1) Availability of vacant land; and 2) The size of the Disaster Event itself. The Map above depicts the Orleans Parish Waste Collection Pad for the Hurricane Katrina Project and was 3.5 acres in size. The sizes (in acres) of the other Parish Waste Collection Pads were as follows: St. Tammany - 4; Upper Jefferson - 3; Lower Jefferson (Grand Isle) - 1.5; Plaquemines - 8; St. Bernard - 3; Vermillion - 2. The Plaquemines Parish Waste Collection Pad was considerably larger than any of the other Pads, due to the large numbers of Orphaned Containers and 55-gallon drums recovered.
